

LOAN (PROVISION OF COOL STORES).

11 GEO. VI. No. 9.

AN ACT to amend the *Loan (Provision of Cool Stores) Act 1941*. [27 March, 1947.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Loan (Provision of Cool Stores) Act 1947*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Loan (Provision of Cool Stores) Act 1941**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section four of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section substituted therefor:—

“4. The Governor may make regulations, not inconsistent with this Act, prescribing all matters which are required or permitted to be prescribed, or which are necessary or convenient to be prescribed for carrying out and giving effect to the provisions of this Act, and in particular may make regulations providing for and prescribing—

- (a) the control, management, and use of cool storage facilities constructed or extended out of moneys provided under this Act (in this section referred to as ‘cool stores’);
- (b) the conditions to be observed by persons using cool stores; and
- (c) the fees and charges to be paid for the use of cool stores,

and any such regulations may be made to apply generally to all cool stores or to any particular cool store.”
