

## NATIONAL PARKS AND WILDLIFE AMENDMENT (ADVISORY COUNCIL) ACT 1995

No. 93 of 1995

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# AN ACT to amend the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1970*[Royal Assent 24 November 1995]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

#### Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the National Parks and Wildlife Amendment (Advisory Council) Act 1995.

#### Commencement

2—This Act commences on the thirtieth day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

#### Principal Act

3—In this Act, the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1970\* is referred to as the Principal Act.

## Section 9 amended (Establishment and functions of the National Parks and Wildlife Advisory Council)

- 4—Section 9 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:—
  - (2) The functions of the Council are as follows:—
    - (a) to advise the Minister on the administration of this Act, including matters referred to it by the Minister;
    - (b) to provide a forum for consultation on policy issues of State significance that are related to this Act;
    - (c) to maintain an overview of the relevance of the Director's role and achievements relative to public expectations;
    - (d) to promote understanding and acceptance of the Director's role and associated programs;
    - (e) to encourage, and act as a focal point for, community support for projects carried out and services provided under this Act;
    - (f) to review management plans for reserved land.

### Section 10 amended (Constitution, &c., of the Council)

- 5—Section 10 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—
  - (a) by omitting subsections (1), (2) and (3) and substituting the following subsections:—
    - (1) The Council consists of not more than 12 persons nominated by the Minister.
    - (2) The persons nominated for membership of the Council are to be persons who, in the opinion of the Minister—
      - (a) have an interest in, and an ability to contribute to, the objectives of this Act; and
      - (b) have the capacity to offer independent advice, taking into account community views and expectations.
      - (3) The members are appointed by the Governor.
    - (3A) The Governor may appoint a member as chairperson of the Council.
  - (b) by omitting from subsection (4) "chairman" and substituting "chairperson";
  - (c) by omitting from subsection (4) "his" and substituting "his or her":
  - (d) by omitting from subsection (8) "chairman" (twice occurring) and substituting "chairperson";
  - (e) by omitting from subsection (8) "he" and substituting "the chairperson";
  - (f) by omitting from subsection (9) "chairman" and substituting "chairperson";
  - (g) by omitting from subsection (13) "chairman" and substituting "chairperson";
  - (h) by omitting from subsection (13) "he" and substituting "the chairperson".

### Transitional provision

**6**—(1) In this section—

"appointment" means appointment under section 10 (1) of the Principal Act as in force immediately before the commencement day;

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- "commencement day" means the day on which this Act commences;
- "Council" means the National Parks and Wildlife Advisory Council established under section 9 (1) of the Principal Act.
- (2) The appointment of a person who was a member of the Council immediately before the commencement day is terminated but that person may, if eligible, be nominated and appointed as a member of the Council in accordance with the Principal Act as amended by this Act.
