AN ACT to amend the Public Health Act 1962.

[27 May 1976]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- **1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Health Act* 1976.
- Short title and citation.
- (2) The *Public Health Act* 1962, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Certain places of assembly to be approved by the Minister.

- 2 Section 57 of the Principal Act is amended—
- (a) by omitting from subsection (3) (a) the words "the Secretary for Local Government and by him to"; and
- (b) by omitting from subsection (3) (a) the words "the Minister" (second occurring) and substituting the word "him".

Certain premises to be approved by Minister.

- 3 Section 120A of the Principal Act is amended—
- (a) by omitting from subsection (2) (a) the words "the Secretary for Local Government and by him to"; and
- (b) by omitting from subsection (2) (a) the words "the Minister" (second occurring) and substituting the word "him".
