AN ACT to amend the *Public Health Act* 1935.
[10 December, 1940.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as
follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Public Health Act* (No. 2) 1940. Short title.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting—

- I. At the end of paragraph xxvi. of section one hundred and eight thereof the words “or in any rural industry”:

II. In subsection (3) of section one hundred and twelve thereof—

(a) Before “privy” in the first line of paragraph I. the words “bathroom and”: and

(b) After paragraph III. the following new paragraph IV.—

“IV. The notification to the Director by prescribed persons, in the prescribed manner and at presented times, of the death of any person dying as the result of pregnancy, or of childbirth, or as the result of any complications arising from, or following upon, pregnancy or childbirth.”: and

Section 123.

III. After “structure,” in paragraph II. of subsection (1) of section one hundred and twenty-three thereof the words “and height.”
