2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (2) of section sixty-two thereof the following new subsection (3)—

“(3) The regulations may provide for the registration as prescribed of all premises used by persons engaged in the business of hatching poultry or the sale of chickens under a prescribed age, and the conditions on which such registration may be permitted, and the duties of such persons in relation to such business, and may empower the Governor by proclamation to declare that poultry shall include any bird specified in such proclamation.”
