THE SECOND SCHEDULE

TABLE OF DISEASES.

Arsenic, phosphorus, lead, mercury, or other mineral poisoning.
 Anthrax.
 Poisoning by benzol or its homologues, or their derivatives, preparations or compounds.
 Poisoning by hydrogen sulphide or carbon bisulphide.
 Poisoning by nitrous or other acid fumes.
 Poisoning by cyanogen compounds.
 Poisoning by carbon monoxide or carbon dioxide.
 Poisoning by other toxic gas.
 Chrome ulceration.
 Dermatitis produced by oil, grease, acids, alkalies, turpentine, tar, industrial solvents, radioactive radiations, cold, heat, photosensitization, or dust; or ulceration of the mucous membranes of the nose or mouth produced by dust.
 Epithelioma of the skin.
 Pneumonokoniosis.
 Nystagmus.
 Subcutaneous cellulitis of the hand (beat hand).
 Subcutaneous cellulitis over the patella (miner's beat knee).
 Acute bursitis over the elbow (miner's beat elbow).
 Inflammation of the synovial lining of the wrist joint and tendon sheath.
 Telegraphist's cramp.
 Compressed air illness.
 Inflammation of the synovial lining of tendon sheaths.

STATE ADVANCES.

11 & 12 GEO. VI. No. 94.

AN ACT to amend the *State Advances Act* 1935.
 [19 December, 1947.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *State Advances Act* 1947.

(2) The *State Advances Act* 1935*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 The Board shall be deemed to have, and always to have had, power to act as the delegate of a prescribed authority under the *Re-establishment and Employment Act 1945** of the Commonwealth, and to exercise and perform, as such delegate, such of the powers and functions of a prescribed authority under Division 4 of Part VI. of that Act as may be specified in any instrument of delegation under section seven A of that Act.

Board deemed to have power to act as delegate of a prescribed authority under the *Re-establishment and Employment Act 1945* of the Commonwealth.

SHEFFIELD PUBLIC CEMETERY (VESTING.)

11 & 12 GEO. VI. No. 95.

AN ACT to provide for the vesting in His Majesty of certain land at Sheffield known as King George's Park Recreation Reserve, and for purposes incidental thereto. [19 December, 1947.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Sheffield Public Cemetery (Vesting) Act 1947*.

Short title and incorporation.

(2) This Act shall be incorporated with the *Crown Lands Act 1935**.

2 The land described in the schedule, known as King George's Park Recreation Reserve (in this Act referred to as "the said land") shall, on the commencement of this Act, revert to and revest in His Majesty for public purposes, freed and discharged from all estates, interests, trusts, obligations, contracts, licences, and charges, whatsoever.

Vesting of cemetery in the Crown.

3—(1) On the commencement of this Act, the rights of all persons in and to the said land and in any graves, tombs, vaults, monuments, tombstones, and other memorials therein shall wholly cease.

Rights to graves and memorials determined.
