Employment and Training (Amendment) Act 1993

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

PART 1—PRELIMINARY

1. *Purpose*

The purpose of this Act is to repeal redundant provisions of the **Employment and Training Act 1981**.

2. *Commencement*

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Section headings appear in bold italics and are not part of the Act.

3. *Principal Act*

In this Act, the **Employment and Training Act 1981** is called the **Principal Act**.

4. *Definitions*

In section 17A of the **Principal Act**—

- (a) for “In this section and in sections 17B, 17BA and 17F unless inconsistent with the context or subject-matter—” **substitute** “In this Act—”;
- (b) after the definition of “remuneration” **insert**—

‘“**Secretary**” means the Secretary to the Department of Education;’.

5. *Amendment of sections 17E, 17F and 18*

In the **Principal Act**—

- (a) in sections 17E and 17F, for “Director-General” (wherever occurring) **substitute** “**Secretary**”;
- (b) in section 18, paragraphs (a) and (b) are **repealed**.

6. *Repeals*

Sections 2 to 17 of the **Principal Act** are **repealed**.
