Employment and Training (Amendment) Act 1993

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

PART 1-PRELIMINARY

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Act is to repeal redundant provisions of the Employment and Training Act 1981.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Section headings appear in bold italics and are not part of the Act. (See Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984.)

3. Principal Act

Reprinted t No. 83/1987 and subsequently amended by Nos 12/1989 and 45/1990.

In this Act, the Employment and Training Act 1981 is called the Principal Act.

PART 2—AMENDMENT OF EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING ACT 1981

4. Definitions

In section 17A of the Principal Act—

- (a) for "In this section and in sections 17B, 17BA and 17F unless inconsistent with the context or subject-matter-" substitute "In this Act-";
- (b) after the definition of "remuneration" insert—

"Secretary" means the Secretary to the Department of Education;'.

5. Amendment of sections 17E, 17F and 18

In the Principal Act-

- (a) in sections 17E and 17F, for "Director-General" (wherever occurring) substitute "Secretary";
- (b) in section 18, paragraphs (a) and (b) are repealed.
- 6. Repeals

Sections 2 to 17 of the Principal Act are repealed.
