A BILL

to amend the Fisheries Act 1968 to regulate the harvesting of scallops for sale and for other purposes.

Fisheries (Scallops) Act 1991

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Act is—

- (a) to regulate the harvesting of scallops for sale; and
- (b) to make transitional arrangements in relation to the harvesting in the waters of Port Phillip Bay of scallops for sale.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.

Section headings appear in bold italics and are not part of the Act (see Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984).

3. Scallop licences

In the Fisheries Act 1968—

- (a) For section 14(1)(b) substitute—
 - "(b) for the harvesting of scallops for sale;";
- (b) For section 14 (3) substitute—
 - "(3) A licence for the harvesting of scallops for sale (in this Act called a "scallop licence") may be issued only to the person for the time being registered as owner of the boat and entitles that person to harvest from the boat in the 10 waters specified in the licence scallops for sale.
 - (3A) Any scallop licence issued under this section before the commencement of section 3 of the Fisheries (Scallops) Act 1991 and in force as at that commencement is deemed to have been 15 issued under this section as amended by section 3 of the Fisheries (Scallops) Act 1991.";
- (c) In section 15 (1) (h) for "dredging or taking" substitute "harvesting";
- (d) In sections 17 (1) and 17 (3) for "dredging for or 20 taking" substitute "harvesting".

4. Harvesting of scallops in the waters of Port Phillip Bay

After section 14 of the Fisheries Act 1968 insert-

"14AA. Harvesting of scallops in the waters of Port Phillip Bay

- (1) This section applies despite anything to the contrary in this Act or in any scallop licence.
- (2) A person must not harvest from a boat in the waters of Port Phillip Bay scallops for sale during the period commencing on the 30 commencement of section 4 of the Fisheries (Scallops) Act 1991 and ending on 31 December 1991.
- (3) A person must not harvest from a boat in the waters of Port Phillip Bay scallops for sale 35

after 31 December 1991 unless he or she uses a method of harvesting approved by the Minister under sub-section (4).

(4) The Minister, after consultation with the Victorian Fishing Industry Federation, may by notice published in the Government Gazette, specify an approved method of harvesting for the purposes of this section if the Minister is satisfied that the method is suitable, having regard to its effect on the aquatic environment and aquatic flora and living resources.".
