

Telecommunications (Interception) (State Provisions) (Amendment) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The purpose of the Act is to amend the **Telecommunications (Interception) (State Provisions) Act 1988** to permit telephone applications for intercept warrants.

Clause 1 states the purpose of the Bill.

Clause 2 is the commencement provision. The Bill will commence on the day on which it receives Royal Assent.

Clause 3 repeals section 4 of the **Telecommunications (Interception) (State Provisions) Act 1988** which contains the prohibition on telephone applications.
