An Act to apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue to the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and forty-eight and to appropriate Supplies granted in this and the last two preceding Sessions of Parliament.

[23rd December, 1947.]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN—

WE Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in Parliament assembled towards making good supplies which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this and the last two preceding Sessions of Parliament have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted: And be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Preamble.

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty a sum not exceeding Sixteen million four hundred and thirty-six thousand nine hundred and seventeen pounds for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.

2 All sums granted by this Act and the other Acts mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act out of the said Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty amounting as appears by the said Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Thirty-two million five hundred and twenty-six thousand two hundred and one pounds are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 5207 for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule hereto.
