An Act to apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue to the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty and to appropriate the Supplies granted in this and the last preceding Session of Parliament.

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN—

WE Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the Preamble.
Legislative Assembly of Victoria in Parliament assembled towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this and the last preceding Session of Parliament have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned

mentioned and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted: And be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty a sum not exceeding Eight million six hundred and forty-nine thousand nine hundred and eleven pounds for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty.

All sums granted by this Act and the other Acts mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act out of the said Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty amounting as appears by the said Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Eighteen million seven hundred and fifty-seven thousand and forty-six pounds are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 3808 for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule hereto.
