1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty a sum not exceeding Eight million six hundred and forty-nine thousand nine hundred and eleven pounds for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty.

2. All sums granted by this Act and the other Acts mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act out of the said Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty amounting as appears by the said Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Eighteen million seven hundred and fifty-seven thousand and forty-six pounds are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 3808 for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule hereto.
