WE Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in Parliament assembled

making good the supply which assembled towards we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this Session of Parliament have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted: And be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue there shall and Application of may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty a sum not exceeding Four £4,170,967. million one hundred and seventy thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven pounds for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty.

2. All sums granted by this Act and the other Acts Appropriation of supplies. mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act out of the said Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty amounting as appears by the said Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Ten million one £10,100,923. hundred thousand nine hundred and twenty-three pounds are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 2999 for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule hereto.
