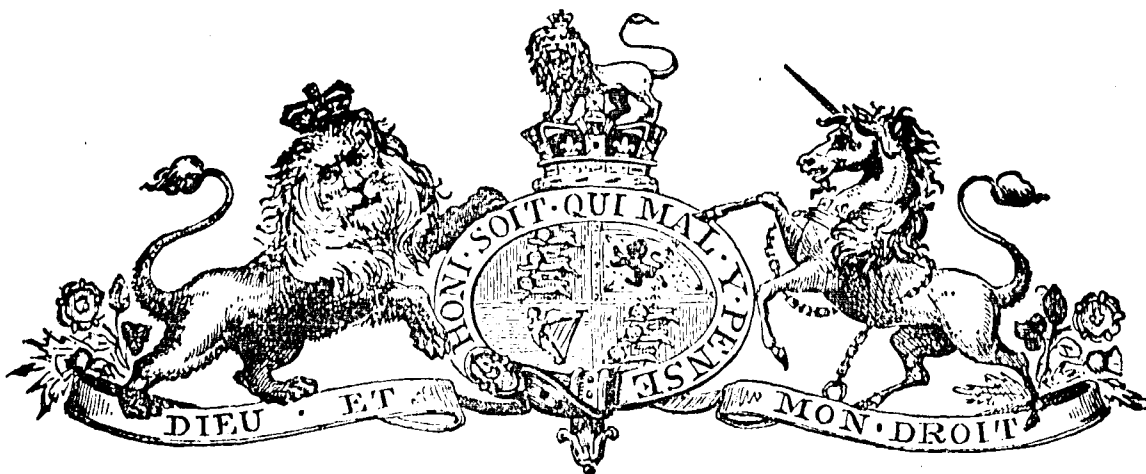

An Act to apply out of the Consolidated Revenue the sum of One million nine hundred and sixty thousand seven hundred and seventy-six pounds to the service of the year One thousand nine hundred and seventeen and One thousand nine hundred and eighteen.

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN—

WE Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in Parliament assembled towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this Session of Parliament have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sum hereinafter mentioned and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted: And be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative

Preamble.

Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. There shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the service of the year One thousand nine hundred and seventeen and One thousand nine hundred and eighteen the sum of One million nine hundred and sixty thousand seven hundred and seventy-six pounds out of the Consolidated Revenue, and the Treasurer of Victoria is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and apply the moneys authorized to be issued and applied.

2. The said sum shall be available to satisfy the warrants under the hand of the Governor under the provisions of the law now in force in respect of any services voted by the Legislative Assembly in this present Session of Parliament.
