An Act to apply out of the Consolidated Revenue the sum of Thirty-six thousand pounds to the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-two and the sum of Five hundred thousand pounds to the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-three [19th *December*, 1862.]

E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with Preamble. the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

I. Out of the consolidated revenue there shall be issued and applied Issue and application from time to time during the year One thousand eight hundred and sixtytwo any sums of money not exceeding Thirty-six thousand pounds which have been voted by the Legislative Assembly for the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-two.

II. Out of the consolidated revenue there shall be issued and applied from time to time any sums of money not exceeding Five hundred thousand pounds which have been voted for the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-three prior to the passing of this Act.
