An Act to amend the Act intituled "An Act to limit

7 HEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act passed in the twenty- Preamble. third year of the Reign of Her Majesty intituled "An Act to " limit the number of persons holding offices under the Crown who may "sit and vote in the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of "Victoria" Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say)-

I. No person being an uncertificated bankrupt or insolvent shall Uncertificated bankbe capable of being elected a member of the Legislative Assembly and if any such person shall be elected and returned as a member of the Assembly such election and return shall be void and if any person so elected shall sit or vote as a member of the said Assembly he shall forfeit and pay the sum of two hundred pounds for every day on which he shall so sit or vote to be recovered with full costs of suit by any person who shall sue for the same in any court of the said colony having competent jurisdiction.
