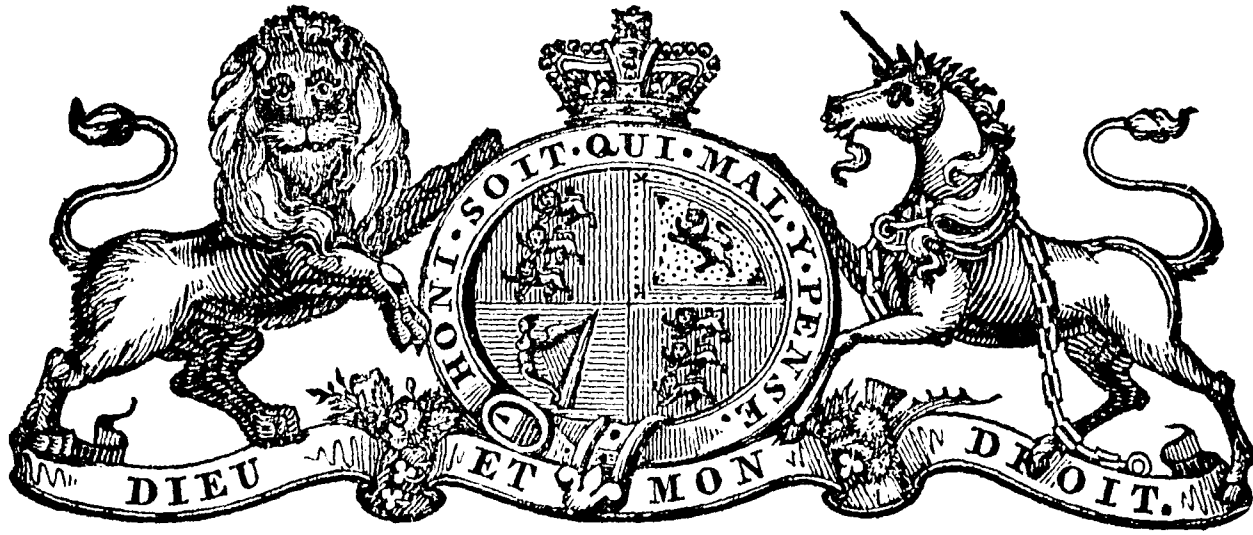

No. CLXXXIX.

An Act to repeal the appropriation of the Sum provided for the payment of the Salaries of the Governor's Staff and of the Governor's Travelling and other Expenses.

[Reserved 2nd September, 1863. Royal Assent proclaimed, 22nd March, 1864.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal the appropriation of the sum of Five thousand pounds provided for the payment of the salaries of the Governor's Staff and of the Governor's travelling and other expenses so that every future Governor shall out of his salary of Ten thousand pounds defray the salaries of his staff and his travelling and all other expenses except those of repairs to Government House Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

I. The Act of the Legislature of Victoria passed in the eighteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty and numbered forty-three and so much of the Constitution Act and the Schedule thereto marked D. as relates to the payment of the sum of Five thousand pounds for salaries of the Governor's staff repairs to Government House and the Governor's travelling and other expenses shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

II. The Governor shall not receive in any year for the salaries of the staff or for travelling expenses or for any other allowances or contingencies whatsoever any sum beyond the sum of Ten thousand pounds for the Governor's salary named in the said first part of the schedule annexed to the Constitution Act and marked D. and shall defray the salaries of his staff his travelling and all other expenses except repairs to Government House out of such salary.
