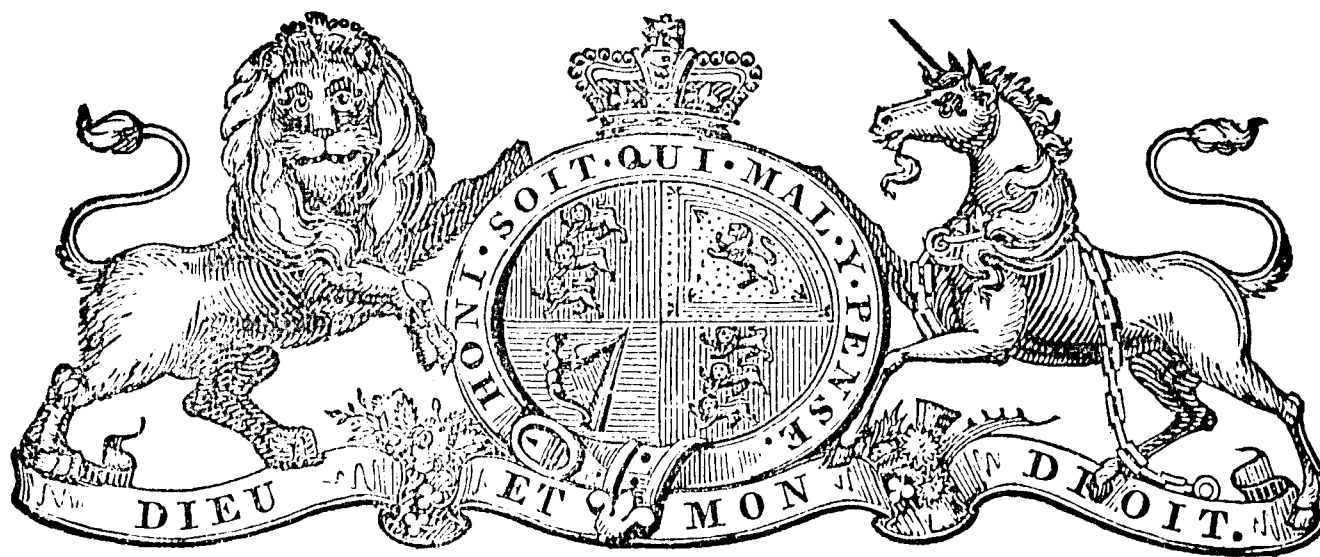

An Act to sanction the issue and application of certain Sums of Money from "The Railway Loan Liquidation and Construction Account" established under the provision of section forty-two of 33 Vict. No. 360.

[20th *December* 1877.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to sanction the issue and application from "The Railway Loan Liquidation and Construction Account" of the sum hereinafter mentioned: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Preamble.

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in the forty-third section of "*The Land Act* 1869" the Treasurer of Victoria is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and apply from "The Railway Loan Liquidation and Construction Account" a sum not exceeding Ten thousand pounds to pay liabilities contracted for surveys of proposed new lines of railway prior to the passing of this Act and to meet necessary expenditure for further surveys of lines of railway.
