An Act relating to Agricultural Education.

[20th November, 1962.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Agricultural Education* Short title.
(Continuation) Act 1962.

(2) The *Agricultural Education Act* 1958 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2. (1) The Principal Act shall be amended as follows :—

- (b) In section four for the words "One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine" there shall be substituted the words "One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two";

- (c) In sub-section (1) of section five for the words "thirteen years" there shall be substituted the words "sixteen years".

Continuation
of Principal
Act and
retrospective

- (2) The Principal Act shall be deemed to have been so amended on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two and shall be deemed to have continued and shall continue in operation accordingly.

Saving.

- (3) All persons things and circumstances appointed or created by or under the Principal Act or existing or continuing under that Act at the said thirtieth day of June shall have the same status operation and effect as they respectively would have had if the Principal Act had not expired on that date but had been amended as provided by this Act on that date.
