An Act to amend Section Six of the *Benefit Associations Act 1951*.

[15th November, 1955.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Benefit Associations (Amendment) Act 1955* and shall be read and construed as one with the *Benefit Associations Act 1951* (hereinafter called the Principal Act) and any Act amending the same which Acts and this Act may be cited together as the *Benefit Associations Acts*.

2. For sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of sub-section (2) of section six of the Principal Act there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph:—

“(ii) in the case of a hospital benefit—shall exceed such amount or respective amounts as are for the time being fixed for the purpose by Order of the Governor in Council made on the recommendation in writing of the Government Statist and published in the *Government Gazette*”.
