An Act to authorize the Council of the City of Collingwood to pay certain Gratuities to certain retired Employés of the said Council and for other purposes.

[4th December, 1933.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the council of the city of Collingwood as from the thirty-first day of December One thousand nine hundred and thirty-one terminated the employment of certain persons theretofore employed by the said council whose names are set out in the first column of the Schedule to this Act and who had on or before that date attained the age of sixty-five years: And whereas it is expedient that the said council be authorized to expend from the municipal fund a sum of Nine hundred and thirty pounds in the payment to the said persons or, if any of the said persons dies before such payment, to such surviving relative or relatives of such person as the said council thinks fit, of gratuities of the several amounts respectively set out in the second column of the said Schedule opposite the names of the several persons aforesaid: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the *City of Collingwood (Gratuities) Act 1933* and shall be read and construed as one with the *Local Government Act 1928* and any Act amending the same, all of which Acts and this Act may be cited together as the *Local Government Acts*.

2. The council of the city of Collingwood is hereby authorized to expend from the municipal fund (which is hereby declared to be available for the purpose) a sum of Nine hundred and thirty pounds in the payment to the persons whose names are set out in the first column of the Schedule to this Act or, if any of the said persons dies before such payment, to such surviving relative or relatives of such person as the said council thinks fit, of gratuities of the several amounts respectively set out in the second column of the said Schedule opposite the names of the several persons aforesaid.
