No. 1581.

An Act to further continue in force Part III. of the Employers and Employe's Act 1890. [19th December, 1898.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled

and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):---

1. This Act shall be called the Employers and Employés Act 1890 Short title. Further Continuation Act 1898.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section forty-five of the Part III. of No. 108? Employers and Employés Act 1890 or any subsequent Act, Part III. of to be continued. the Employers and Employés Act 1890, which relates to the liability of employers for injuries to employés, shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of December One thousand nine hundred and thence until the end of the next ensuing Session and no longer unless Parliament otherwise determines; and all actions commenced under the said Part before the end of the said Session shall be continued as if such Part had not expired.
