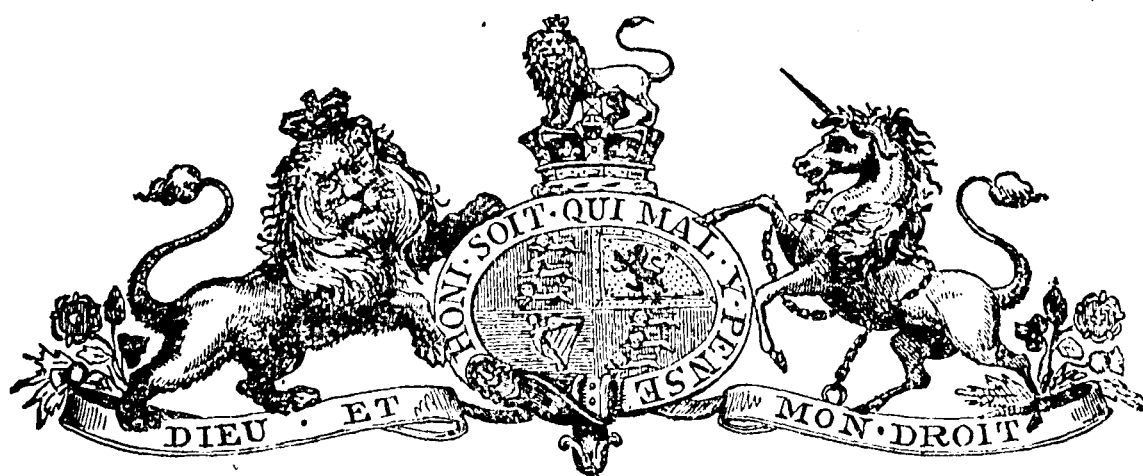

An Act to continue the Foodstuffs and
Commodities Acts. [30th April, 1915.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Foodstuffs and Commodities Act 1915* and shall be read and construed as one with the *Foodstuffs and Commodities Act 1914* and the *Foodstuffs and Commodities Act 1914 Continuation Act 1914* which Acts and this Act may be cited together as the Foodstuffs and Commodities Acts.

2. (1) The Foodstuffs and Commodities Acts shall continue in operation until the first day of October One thousand nine hundred and fifteen and no longer.

(2) The expiration of the said Acts shall not affect—

- (a) the previous operation of or anything duly done or suffered under the said Acts ;
- (b) any penalty forfeiture or punishment incurred under the said Acts ; or
- (c) any investigation legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such penalty forfeiture or punishment.

Saving.

And any such investigation legal proceeding or remedy may be instituted continued and enforced and any such penalty forfeiture or punishment may be imposed as if the said Acts had not expired.
