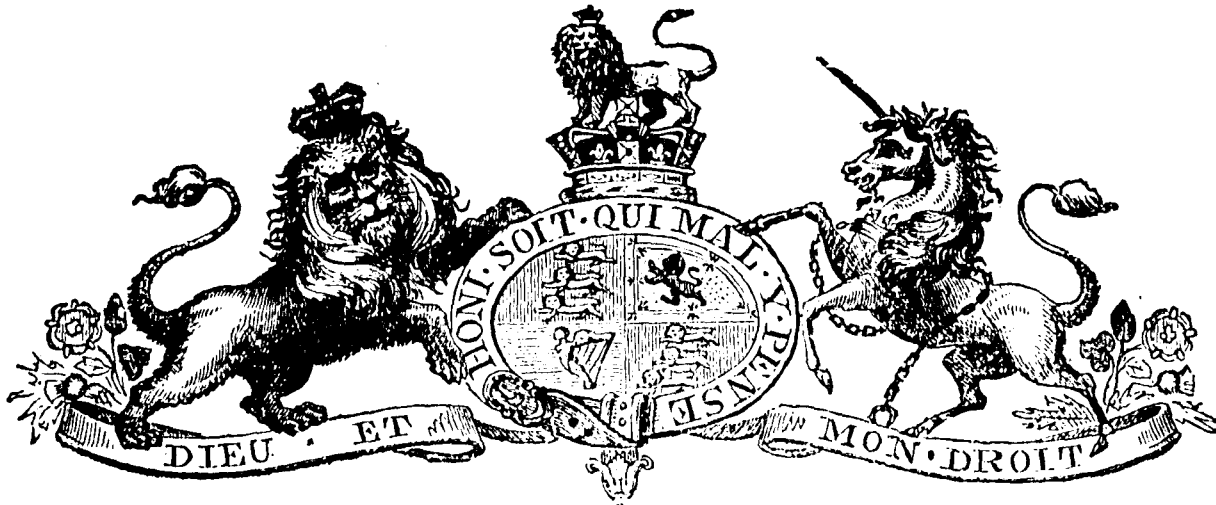

An Act to provide for the Sale of certain Land  
to the Shire of Hampden by a Councillor  
of the said Shire.

[12th October, 1909.]

**W**HEREAS the council of the shire of Hampden for the purpose of  
executing certain works and undertakings which they are  
authorized by the Local Government Acts to execute desire in the name  
and on behalf of the said shire to purchase as a site for gravel pits  
certain land situate in the parish of Colongulac, county of Hampden,  
and described in the Schedule to this Act, from James Chester Manifold,  
of Talindert, near Camperdown, grazier, who is willing to sell the same :  
And whereas the said James Chester Manifold being a councillor of the  
said shire would if he sold or contracted to sell the said land to the  
said council as aforesaid be incapable of being or continuing a councillor  
of the said shire and be subject to the disqualifications incapacities and  
penalties provided by the Local Government Acts in the case of a coun-  
cillor who is concerned or participating in any manner whether directly  
or indirectly in any contract with any municipality or in the profit of  
any such contract or who acts as a councillor being incapacitated under  
the said Acts : And whereas it is expedient to provide for the sale of  
such land as aforesaid and to indemnify the said James Chester Manifold  
from such disqualifications incapacities and penalties : Be it therefore  
enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice  
and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly  
of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority  
of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Hampden Land Purchase* Short title.  
*Act 1909.* 2. Notwithstanding

Indemnity to the vendor for sale or transfer of or contract to sell or transfer land described in the Schedule hereto.

Schedule.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in sections fifty-two fifty-three and fifty-five of the *Local Government Act* 1903 as amended by any Act, the said James Chester Manifold is hereby empowered to sell and transfer or to contract or agree to sell or transfer to the council of the shire of Hampden in the name and on behalf of the said shire the land described in the Schedule to this Act and shall be and is hereby indemnified freed and discharged from any incapacity or penalty to which he would otherwise be liable under the said sections or any of them as a councillor of the shire of Hampden and from any incapacity or disqualification to be or continue such councillor by reason of such sale or transfer or by reason of any such contract or agreement.

## Section 2.

## SCHEDULE.

All that piece of land being part of Crown allotments F and D, section 13, parish of Colongulac, county of Hampden, containing five acres two roods fifteen and eight-tenths perches: Commencing at a point on a line bearing south  $60^{\circ} 7'$  east two thousand nine hundred and fourteen links from the south-west corner of allotment G, section 13, parish of Colongulac; thence north  $29^{\circ} 53'$  east four hundred and fifty-nine links; thence south  $58^{\circ} 36'$  east two hundred and thirty-two links; thence south  $49^{\circ} 40'$  east eight hundred and two links; thence south  $26^{\circ} 0'$  west one hundred links; thence south  $59^{\circ} 32'$  east seven hundred and fifty links; thence south  $29^{\circ} 53'$  west two hundred links; and thence north  $60^{\circ} 7'$  west one thousand seven hundred and seventy-seven links to the point of commencement.
