An Act relating to the Remuneration of Judges of the
Supreme Court and County Court.

[14th December, 1965.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament
assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is
to say):—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Judges' Salaries and Allowances Act 1965*. Short title.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on the 1st day of December, 1965. Commence-
ment.

2. Paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section 12 of the
Supreme Court Act 1958 is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) In sub-paragraph (i) for the words "Seven thousand
three hundred and fifty pounds" there shall be
substituted the words "Eight thousand six hundred
and fifty pounds"; and

(b) In sub-paragraph (ii) for the words "Six thousand
seven hundred pounds" there shall be substituted
the words "Seven thousand eight hundred and fifty
pounds".

3. In sub-section (1) of section 10 of the *County Court Act* 1958—

- (a) For the words “Five thousand and fifty pounds” there shall be substituted the words “Five thousand eight hundred and fifty pounds”; and
 - (b) For the words “One hundred and fifty pounds” there shall be substituted the words “Two hundred and fifty pounds”.
