An Act to amend Section Three hundred and eighty-three
of the *Mines Act* 1958.

[12th October, 1965.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament
assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is
to say):—

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Mines (Regulations) Act*
1965.

to as the Principal Act.

2. Section three hundred and eighty-three of the Principal Act
shall be amended as follows :—

(a) After paragraph (d) there shall be inserted the following
paragraphs :—

Regulations.

“(da) regulating and controlling the use of explosives in
mines and quarries ;

(db) the issue to fit and proper persons of permits to use
explosives in mines and quarries the forms of the
permits and the conditions to which they are to be
subject the imposition and collection of fees for the
permits and prohibiting persons from so using
explosives without a permit ;”

(b) For paragraph (g) there shall be substituted the following paragraph :—

“(g) imposing any penalty not exceeding Fifty pounds for any offence against any regulation made under this section and in the case of a continuing offence a further daily penalty not exceeding Five pounds.”
