# Margarine (Repeal) Act 1994

[Assented to 18 October 1994]

## The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

#### 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Act is to repeal the Margarine Act 1975 and provide for the refund of licence fees.

#### 2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

## 3. Repeal of the Margarine Act 1975

The Margarine Act 1975 is repealed.

#### 4. Refund of licence fees

- (1) The Minister, on application in writing by the holder of a licence in force under the Margarine Act 1975 immediately before the commencement of section 3, must refund to the holder the amount of the fee paid for the licence by the holder.
- (2) The Consolidated Fund is appropriated to the necessary extent to enable refunds to be paid in accordance with sub-section (1).
