Melbourne Corporation (Election of Council) (Amendment) Act 1988

[Assented to 11 May 1988]

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose.

1. The purpose of this Act is to amend the Melbourne Corporation (Election of Council) Act 1982 to enable the holding of a general election in 1988.

Commencement.

2. This Act comes into operation on a day to be proclaimed.

Amendment of Melbourne Corporation (Election of Council) Act 1982.

- 3. The Melbourne Corporation (Election of Council) Act 1982 is amended as follows:
 - (a) In section 3 (2) for "under the Local Government Act 1958 for the general election of the council of the city of Melbourne in 1988" substitute "for the general election of the council of the city of Melbourne in 1991";

(b) In section 64 (b) for "and 1987" substitute ", 1987, 1988, 1989 and 1990".
