## **Melbourne Corporation (Election of Council) (Amendment) Act 1988**

[Assented to 11 May 1988]

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

### **Purpose.**

1. The purpose of this Act is to amend the *Melbourne Corporation (Election of Council) Act 1982* to enable the holding of a general election in 1988.

### **Commencement.**

2. This Act comes into operation on a day to be proclaimed.

### **Amendment of *Melbourne Corporation (Election of Council) Act 1982*.**

3. The *Melbourne Corporation (Election of Council) Act 1982* is amended as follows:

- (a) In section 3 (2) for "under the *Local Government Act 1958* for the general election of the council of the city of Melbourne in 1988" substitute "for the general election of the council of the city of Melbourne in 1991";

- (b) In section 64 (b) for “and 1987” substitute “, 1987, 1988, 1989 and 1990”.
