An Act to further amend Section Four of the Motor Omnibus Act 1924.

[30th December, 1927.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Short title construction and citation. Nos. 3378, 3439.

1. This Act may be cited as the Motor Omnibus Act 1927 and shall be read and construed as one with the Motor Omnibus Act 1924 (hereinafter called the Principal Act) and the Act amending the same which Acts and this Act may be cited together as the Motor Omnibus Acts.

Amendment of No. 3378 s. 4 (1).

2. At the end of sub-section (1) of section four of the Principal Act there shall be inserted the words—

Penalties for motor omnibus plying for hire and not registered and heensed. "and any person plying for hire with any motor omnibus not so registered and licensed and the owner of any such motor omnibus permitting or concerned in any plying for hire therewith shall severally be guilty of an offence against this Act and shall be liable for a first offence to a penalty of not more than Twenty pounds, and for a second offence to a penalty of not less than Fifty pounds and not more than One hundred pounds and for any subsequent offence to a penalty of One hundred pounds."
