An Act to continue the Operation of the National Security (Emergency Powers) Act 1939.

[2nd September, 1942.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the National Security (Emergency Powers) Continuation Act 1942 and shall be read and construed as one with the National Security (Emergency Powers) Act 1939 (hereinafter called the Principal Act) and the Acts amending the same which Acts and this Act may be cited together as the National Security (Emergency Powers) Acts.
