An Act to amend Section Two and the Title of the
Police Offences (Raffles) Act 1940 and Section
 Eighty-eight of the *Police Offences Act 1928*.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by

Commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Police Offences (Control of Raffles) Act 1956* and shall be read and construed as one with the *Police Offences Act 1928* (hereinafter called the Principal Act) and any Act and enactment amending the same all of which Acts and enactments and this Act may be cited together as the *Police Offences Acts*.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

2. (1) In sub-section (1) of section two of the *Police Offences (Raffles) Act 1940* after the expression "*Patriotic Funds Act 1939*" there shall be inserted the words "or to a fund intended to be appropriated exclusively to charitable purposes".
