An Act to sanction the issue and application of certain Sums of Money available under Loan Acts for Public Works and other purposes.

[30th December, 1919.]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Short title,

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Works Loan Application Act 1919.

2. There

There may be issued and applied out of any loan Issue and authorized by Parliament and appropriated by Parliament for public works and other purposes any sums of money not exceeding in the whole Five hundred thousand pounds for the public works and other purposes mentioned in the Schedule to this Act and in sums not exceeding the amounts specified therein.

3. No authority other than this Act is necessary to Authority. authorize the expenditure herein provided.
