An Act to amend the Law relating to the Royal Agricultural Show Day.

[2nd September, 1913.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Royal Agricultural Show Day Act 1913*. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any Act the Thursday before the last Saturday in September in each year in lieu of the first Thursday in September shall so far as relates to the municipal districts specified in the Schedule to the *Royal Agricultural Show Day Act 1903* be observed as a holiday in the public offices within the meaning of the *Public Service Act 1890* as amended by any Act and be a bank holiday within the meaning of the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* as amended by any Act.
