An Act to amend the *Railway Loan Act 1900*.

[27th December, 1900.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Railway Loan Amendment Act 1900*. Short title.

2. In section two of the *Railway Loan Act 1900* for the words "Five hundred thousand" there shall be substituted the words "One million." Increase of amount of loan to be raised.

3. In section three of the *Railway Loan Act 1900* for the words "Ten thousand" there shall be substituted the words "Twenty thousand"; and for the words "Two hundred thousand" there shall be substituted the words "Four hundred thousand." Increase of sum to be set apart annually to meet debentures.

4. For the First Schedule to the *Railway Loan Act 1900* there shall be substituted the Schedule to this Act. Amendment of First Schedule.
