An Act to sanction the Issue and Application of certain Sums of Money available for Railways under Loan Acts or in the State Loans Repayment Fund, and for other purposes.

[21st December, 1945.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Railway Loan short title. Application Act 1945.
- 2. There may be issued and applied out of any loan issue and authorized by Parliament and appropriated by Parliament application of £1,241,550 out for the construction of railways or tramways and works of loan funds for railways or connected with either (including rolling-stock) or out of works. any moneys in the State Loans Repayment Fund any sums of money not exceeding in the whole One million two hundred and forty-one thousand five hundred and fifty pounds for the works and purposes mentioned in the Schedule to this Act and in sums not exceeding the amounts schedule.

specified therein in the column headed "Amount Issued and Applied," and, with the sanction of the Minister and (where the lands in question are Crown lands) the sanction of the Commissioner of Crown Lands and Survey, The Victorian Railways Commissioners may enter upon take and use such lands as are required for any of the purposes specified in the Schedule to this Act and the provisions of sub-section (3) of section eighty of the Railways Act 1928 shall extend and apply to the exercise of the powers conferred by this section with respect to such of the said lands as are not unalienated Crown lands.

Authority.

3. No authority other than this Act is necessary to authorize the expenditure herein provided.

No expenditure for railways or tramways out of loans except under this Act.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in any Railway Construction Act or Railway Loan Application Act in force before the commencement of this Act, no money shall by virtue of any such Act be expended out of any loan funds for railways or tramways or works connected therewith other than such as are respectively specified in the column headed "Amount Issued and Applied" in the Schedule to this Act and to the extent therein mentioned.
