An Act relating to Responsible Ministers of the
Crown.

[14th October, 1958.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Responsible Ministers Act* 1958 and shall be read and construed as one with *The Constitution Act Amendment Act* 1956 (hereinafter called the Principal Act) and the Acts amending the same which Acts and this Act may be cited together as The Constitution Act Amendment Acts.

2. Section fifteen of the Principal Act shall be amended as follows:—

- (a) In sub-section (1) for the word "twelve" there shall be substituted the word "fourteen";
- (b) In sub-section (3) for the word "eight" there shall be substituted the word "ten"; and
- (c) Sub-section (4) shall be repealed.

3. Sub-section (1) of section thirty-four of the Principal Act shall be amended as follows:—

- (a) In paragraph (c) for the word “ten” there shall be substituted the word “twelve”; and
- (b) Paragraph (d) shall be repealed.
