An Act to amend Section Five of the *Solicitor-General Act 1958*.

[30th April, 1963.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Solicitor-General (Pensions) Act 1963*. Short title.

2. In paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section five of the *Solicitor-General Act 1958* for the words "fifteen years" there shall be substituted the words "twelve years".
