An Act to amend Section Seven of the *Swine Act* 1958.

[13th April, 1965.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Swine (Amendment) Act* 1965. Short title.

(2) The *Swine Act* 1958 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act. Principal Act No. 6389 as amended by Nos. 6886, 7192.

2. For sub-sections (2) and (3) of section seven of the Principal Act there shall be substituted the following sub-sections:— Amendment of No. 6389 s. 7.

“(2) The residual value of any pig so destroyed shall be the moneys received by the owner of the pig from the sale of the carcass and offal thereof. Residual value.”

(3) Arrangements for the sale of the carcass and offal of any pig so destroyed may be made by the Chief Inspector of Stock. Chief Inspector may arrange sale of carcass &c.

(4) The amount of any such residual value shall in every case be deducted from the amount payable as compensation under this Part.

(5) Where the carcass of any pig so destroyed is condemned under Part XV. of the *Health Act* 1958 as unfit for human consumption the costs incurred in connexion with the slaughter of such pig shall be paid from the Swine Compensation Fund."
