

An Act to continue the Operation of certain Provisions of the Stamps Acts relating to the Imposition of Increased Stamp Duties on certain Instruments.

[20th December, 1937.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Stamps (Increased Duty Continuance) Act 1937* and shall be read and construed as one with the *Stamps Act 1928* (hereinafter called the Principal Act) and any Act and enactment amending the same all of which Acts and enactments and this Act may be cited together as the Stamps Acts.

2. (1) The Third Schedule to the Principal Act as amended by any Act is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) For the words “ thirty-first day of December One thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven ” there shall be substituted the words “ thirty-first day of December One thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight ” ; and

(wherever occurring) there shall be substituted

(2) In sub-section (3) of section two of the *Stamps Act*
1932 as amended by any Act for the words “and thirty-seven”
there shall be substituted the words “and thirty-eight”.
