BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by
and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this
present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the
same as follows (that is to say):—

Short title and
commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Surplus Revenue Act*
1945 and shall be deemed and taken to have come into
operation on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine
hundred and forty-five.

2. (1) Notwithstanding anything in any Act the sum
of Three hundred and forty-nine thousand pounds being
excess of receipts on account of the consolidated revenue
over expenditure out of consolidated revenue of the year
ended on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine
hundred and forty-five shall be applied to the several
purposes and to the amounts respectively set forth in the
Schedule to this Act.
