1. This Act may be cited as the Surplus Revenue Act 1945 and shall be deemed and taken to have come into operation on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and forty-five.

2. (1) Notwithstanding anything in any Act the sum of Three hundred and forty-nine thousand pounds being excess of receipts on account of the consolidated revenue over expenditure out of consolidated revenue of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and forty-five shall be applied to the several purposes and to the amounts respectively set forth in the Schedule to this Act.

(2) The Treasurer may without further or other authority than this Act apply the said excess to the several purposes and to the amounts respectively set forth in the Schedule to this Act.
