An Act to revoke the Permanent Reservation of certain Land in the Municipal District of Williamstown as a Site for Military Purposes.

[6th September, 1915.]

WHEREAS by an Order in Council dated the twenty-seventh day of October One thousand eight hundred and eighty-four the land described in the Schedule to this Act was permanently reserved as a site for military purposes: And whereas it is expedient that the permanent reservation of the said land should be revoked in order that the same may be dealt with as unalienated land of the Crown and if the Governor in Council thinks fit sold to the Commonwealth of Australia for defence purposes: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Preamble.

Schedule.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Williamstown Land Act* 1915. Short title.

2. The said recited Order in Council bearing date the twenty-seventh day of October One thousand eight hundred and eighty-four permanently reserving from sale as a site for military purposes the land described in the Schedule to this Act is hereby revoked and the land described in the said Schedule— Revocation of permanent reservation.

Schedule.

shall be deemed to be and may be dealt with as unalienated land of the Crown; and

may if the Governor in Council thinks fit be sold and granted to the Commonwealth of Australia as a site for defence purposes for such price and upon such terms and subject to such covenants conditions exceptions and reservations as to the Governor in Council seem fit.

Power to sell to Commonwealth of Australia for defence purposes.

Land permanently reserved by Order in Council of the 27th October, 1884, as a Site for Military Purposes, vide Government Gazette of the 3rd October, 1884, page 2825, and the 31st October, 1884, page 3040.

One acre one rood one perch and one-tenth, county of Bourke, municipal district of Williamstown, being allotment 12 of section 24: Commencing at the intersection of the south-eastern side of Pasco-street and the south-western side of Melbourne-road; bounded thence by the said road bearing S. $45^{\circ} 36'$ E. three chains; thence by allotments 13 and 10 bearing S. $44^{\circ} 24'$ W. four chains nineteen links; thence by allotment 11 bearing N. $45^{\circ} 36'$ W. three chains; and thence by Pasco-street aforesaid bearing N. $44^{\circ} 24'$ E. four chains nineteen links to the point of commencement.
