An Act to sanction the issue and application of certain Sums of Money available under Loan Acts for Water Supply in Country Districts and for other purposes.

[14th December, 1906.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Water Supply Loans Application Act* 1906. Short title.

2. Pursuant to the provisions of Part VII. of the *Water Act* 1905 the Governor in Council may grant as a loan or further loan or advance on account of any loan to each Waterworks Trust named in the First Part of the Schedule to this Act any sum or sums not exceeding the amount set forth in such Part opposite to the name of such Trust. Loans to Water-works Trusts. No. 2016 ss. 266 et seq. First Part of Schedule.

3. Pursuant to the provisions of Part VII. of the *Water Act* 1905 the Governor in Council may advance as a loan to the local governing body named in the Second Part of the Schedule to this Act any sum or sums not exceeding the amount set forth in such Part opposite to the name of such local governing body. 4. Subject to the provisions of the Mallee Tanks Acts and the *Municipalities Advances Act* 1898 as amended by the *Municipalities Advances Act* 1901 the Governor in Council may grant loans to any of the Municipalities named in such Acts but not exceeding in the whole the amount specified in the Third Part of the Schedule to this Act.

5. The sums specified in the Fourth Part of the Schedule to this Act may be respectively expended by the Board of Land and Works for the purposes therein mentioned.

Expenditure author-

Part of Schedule.

6. The sums specified in the Fifth Part of the Schedule to this Act may be respectively expended by the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission for the purposes therein mentioned.

Power to issue from
loan funds.

7. The Treasurer of Victoria is hereby authorized to issue and apply any sums of money set out in the Schedule to this Act not exceeding in the whole Four hundred and seventy-seven thousand five hundred and two pounds out of any loan authorized by Parliament before the commencement of this Act and appropriated by Parliament for irrigation works and water supply in country districts.

Works declared
to be State works

8. The works specified in the Fourth Part of the Schedule to the *Water Supply Loans Application Act* 1905 and in the Fourth and Fifth Parts of the Schedule to this Act other than those which have by some Act of Parliament passed before the commencement of this Act been declared to be national works of water supply or are described in the Third Schedule to the *Water Act* 1905 as State works of water supply are hereby declared to be State works within the meaning of the *Water Act* 1905.

Amendment of

9. In the Third Part of the Schedule to the *Water Supply Special Funds Application Act* 1904 there shall as from the commencement of the said Act be deemed to have been included the following amendment namely:—

After the words "Mildura railway line" there shall be added the words "purchase of land and expenses in connexion therewith."

No expenditure from

under this Act.

10. Notwithstanding anything contained in any Water Supply Loans Application Act in force before the commencement of this Act (other than the Act No. 1943) no money shall by virtue of any such Loans Application Act be expended out of any Loan Funds for loans to Waterworks Trusts, Local Governing Bodies or Municipalities, or for or towards any waterworks other than such as are specified respectively in the Schedule to this Act and to the extent mentioned therein.
