An Act to sanction the Issue and Application of Loan Money for Works and other Purposes relating to Irrigation Water Supply Drainage Sewerage Flood Protection and River Improvement, and for other purposes.

[27th November, 1962.]

ZE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :---

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Water Supply Loan Application Act 1962.

Issue and application of money from Loan Fund for purposes specified in Schedule.

No loan expenditure for water supply,

2. From the Loan Fund there may be issued and applied the several amounts specified in the Schedule to this Act in the column headed "Proposed Provision" for the respective works and purposes specified opposite thereto, not exceeding Eleven million three hundred thousand pounds in all.

3. (1) Notwithstanding anything in any Water Supply Loan Application Act in force before the commencement of this Act &c., except under this Act. no money shall by virtue of any such Act be expended out of the

Loan Fund for works and purposes relating to irrigation water supply drainage flood protection or river improvement except pursuant to and to the extent authorized by this Act.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in any Loan Application Act in force before the commencement of this Act no money shall by virtue of any such Act be expended under the Sewerage Districis Act 1958 for sewerage works in country districts or under the Latrobe Valley Act 1958 except pursuant to and to the extent authorized by this Act.

4. (1) The sums specified in the First Part of the Schedule State works. to this Act in the column headed "Proposed Provision" may be respectively expended by the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission for the purposes mentioned in the said First Part.

(2) Any sum so expended shall be charged to the Capital Expenditure Borne by the State Account and the liability therefor shall be borne by the State accordingly and shall not be deemed to be a liability of any authority.

(3) Notwithstanding anything in the last preceding sub-section the Governor in Council on the recommendation of the Minister of Water Supply may from time to time by Order adjust any expenditure made under sub-section (1) of this section by transferring from the State to any district or authority concerned the liability for such amount of any such expenditure as the Governor in Council considers reasonable having regard to the development of such district or authority and thereupon the liability for any amount so transferred shall be transferred out of the Capital Expenditure Borne by the State Account and be charged in the books of the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission to such district or authority and be a liability of the appropriate district or authority accordingly.

5. The works specified in the First Part of the Schedule to this Act, other than those which have by some Act of Parliament passed before the commencement of this Act been declared to be National or State works of water supply drainage flood protection or river improvement, are hereby declared to be State works of water supply drainage flood protection or river improvement (as the case may be) within the meaning of the Water Act 1958; and the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission is hereby authorized and directed to construct and carry out all works specified in the First Part of the Schedule to this Act.

6. The sum specified in the Second Part of the Schedule to this Act in the column headed "Proposed Provision" may be expended by the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission for the purposes mentioned in the said Second Part, pursuant to the or schedule. provisions of Part III. of the Water Act 1958.

7. (1) Pursuant to the provisions of Part VII. of the *Water* Act 1958 the Treasurer of Victoria may advance by way of loan from the Loan Fund—

- (a) to each waterworks trust named in the Third Part of the Schedule to this Act any sum or sums not exceeding the amount specified in the Third Part of the said Schedule in the column headed "Proposed Provision" opposite to the name of such trust; and
- (b) to any other waterworks trust (whether constituted before or after the commencement of this Act) any sum or sums less than Four thousand pounds in the case of each such other trust but so that the total sum advanced to all such other trusts does not exceed the amount specified in the last item of the Third Part of the said Schedule in the said column.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in the last preceding sub-section the Governor in Council within six months after the date on which any such advance is made may on the recommendation of the Minister of Water Supply determine whether the whole or any and what part of such advance shall be charged to the Capital Expenditure Borne by the State Account and the liability for the whole or that part (as the case may be) of the capital loan liability represented by such advance shall be borne by the State accordingly and shall not be deemed to be advanced pursuant to the provisions of Part VII. of the *Water Act* 1958.

8. (1) Pursuant to the provisions of Part III. of the *Mildura Irrigation and Water Trusts Act* 1958 the Treasurer of Victoria may advance by way of loan from the Loan Fund to each trust named in the Fourth Part of the Schedule to this Act any sum or sums not exceeding the amount specified in the Fourth Part of the said Schedule in the column headed "Proposed Provision" opposite to the name of such trust.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in the last preceding sub-section the Governor in Council within six months after the date on which any such advance is made may on the recommendation of the Minister of Water Supply determine whether the whole or any and what part of such advance shall be charged to the Capital Expenditure Borne by the State Account and the liability for the whole or that part (as the case may be) of the capital loan liability represented by such advance shall be borne by the State accordingly and shall not be deemed to be advanced pursuant to the provisions of Part III. of the *Mildura Irrigation and Water Trusts Act* 1958.

9. (1) Pursuant

Loan's to Mildura Trusts. No. 6316 Part III. Fourth Part of Schedule. 1962.

9. (1) Pursuant to the provisions of Part VII. of the *Water* Act 1958 the Treasurer of Victoria may advance by way of loan from the Loan Fund to each local governing body named in the Fifth Part of the Schedule to this Act any sum or sums not exceeding the amount specified in the Fifth Part of the said Schedule in the column headed "Proposed Provision" opposite to the name of such local governing body.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in the last preceding sub-section the Governor in Council within six months after the date on which any such advance is made may on the recommendation of the Minister of Water Supply determine whether the whole or any and what part of such advance shall be charged to the Capital Expenditure Borne by the State Account and the liability for the whole or that part (as the case may be) of the capital loan liability represented by such advance shall be borne by the State accordingly and shall not be deemed to be advanced pursuant to the provisions of Part VII. of the *Water Act* 1958.

10. (1) Notwithstanding anything in the Geelong Waterworks and Sewerage Act 1958 or in the Local Government Act 1958 the Treasurer of Victoria may advance by way of loan from the Loan Fund to any authority named in the Sixth Part of the Schedule to this Act any sum or sums not exceeding the amount specified in the Sixth Part of the said Schedule in the column headed "Proposed Provision" opposite to the name of such authority in all respects as if such authority were an authority within the meaning of the Water Act 1958.

(2) Any sum so advanced to any such authority shall be expended on the improvement and extension of water supply works within the urban centre of such authority.

(3) Any sum so advanced to any such authority shall be charged to the Capital Expenditure Borne by the State Account and the liability therefor shall be borne by the State accordingly and shall not be deemed to be a liability of such authority.

11. (1) Notwithstanding anything in Part III. of the Sewerage Districts Act 1958 the Treasurer of Victoria may advance by way of loan from the Loan Fund to any authority named in the Seventh Part of the Schedule to this Act any sum or sums not exceeding the amount specified in the Seventh Part of the said Schedule in the column headed "Proposed Provision" opposite to the name of such authority.

(2) Within six months after the date on which any such advance is made to any sewerage authority the Governor in Council may on the recommendation of the Minister of Water Supply determine whether Loans to Geelong Trust and local governing bodies for urban centres, No. 6263. No. 6299. Sixth Part of Schedule,

the whole or any and what part of such advance shall be transferred and charged to the account kept in the books of the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission called the "Capital Expenditure (Sewerage) Borne by the State Account", and the liability for the whole or that part (as the case may be) of the capital loan liability represented by such advance shall be borne by the State accordingly and shall not be deemed to be a liability of that authority.

12. (1) Pursuant to the provisions of Part IV. of the *River* Improvement Act 1958 or any subsequent Act relating to river improvement and land drainage the Treasurer of Victoria may advance by way of loan from the Loan Fund—

- (a) to any river improvement trust or other authority named in the Eighth Part of the Schedule to this Act any sum or sums not exceeding the amount specified in the Eighth Part of the said Schedule in the column headed "Proposed Provision" opposite to the name of such trust or authority; and
- (b) to any other river improvement or drainage authority (whether constituted before or after the commencement of this Act) such sum or sums as the Treasurer of Victoria thinks fit but so that the total sum advanced to all such other authorities does not exceed the amount specified in the last item of the said Eighth Part in the said column.

(2) Any sum so advanced shall be applied in accordance with any direction given pursuant to any statutory power to direct the application of such sum.

(3) Notwithstanding anything in sub-section (1) of this section the Governor in Council within six months after the date on which any such advance is made to any such trust or authority may on the recommendation of the Minister of Water Supply determine whether the whole or any and what part of such advance shall be charged to the Capital Expenditure Borne by the State Account and the liability for the whole or that part (as the case may be) of the capital loan liability represented by such advance shall be borne by the State accordingly and shall not be deemed to be a liability of such trust or authority.

13. (1) Notwithstanding anything in paragraph (a) of sub-section (3) of section forty-seven of the Latrobe Valley Act 1958, but save as aforesaid pursuant to the provisions of the Latrobe Valley Act 1958 the Treasurer of Victoria may advance by way of loan from the Loan Fund to the Latrobe Valley Water and Sewerage Board any sum or sums not exceeding the amounts specified in the respective items in the Ninth Part of the Schedule to this Act in the column headed "Proposed Provision".

14. (1) The sum specified in the Tenth Part of the Schedule Loans for River Murray works. to this Act in the column headed "Proposed Provision" may Murray wo be expended under and pursuant to the River Murray Waters Acts. of Schedule.
