An Ordinance for the appropriation of the Revenue for the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty and to provide for the payment of certain unforeseen expenses during the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-nine.

WHEREAS it is necessary to provide for the service of the Preamble.
year one thousand eight hundred and fifty, and also for the
panyment

Supplementary charge for the year ending 31st December 1849, £1,501 9s. 11d.

payment of certain unforeseen expenses of the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, for which no provision was made in the estimate of that year;—Be it therefore enacted, by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, that out of the produce of the Revenue of the said colony, there shall and may be issued and applied to defray the supplementary charge for the service of the year ending on the thirty-first of December, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, and not provided for in the Ordinance of that year, a sum not exceeding one thousand five hundred and two pounds, nine shillings, and eleven pence, as detailed in the annexed Schedule No. 1.

II. AND be it enacted, that a sum not exceeding eight thousand six hundred and seventy-nine pounds, one shilling and sixpence, be charged upon the Revenue of the said colony for the service of the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty, and applied in the manner following;—that is to say,

Civil Establishment. For the expenditure of the Civil Establishment, a sum not exceeding four thousand nine hundred and forty pounds, one shilling and sixpence;

Administration of Justice. For Administration of Justice, a sum not exceeding two hundred pounds;

Charitable Allowances. For Charitable Allowances a sum not exceeding one hundred pounds;

Education. For Education, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding sixty pounds;

Hospitals. For Hospitals, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding one hundred and eighty-five pounds;

Police and Gaols. For Police and Gaols, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding seven hundred and thirty-seven pounds;

Rent of Offices. For Rent of Offices, a sum not exceeding thirty pounds.

For Transport and Travelling Expenses a sum not exceeding one hundred and twenty pounds; Transport and Travelling expenses.

For conveyance of Mails a sum not exceeding two hundred and fifty pounds; Conveyance of mails

For Works and Buildings, a sum not exceeding one hundred and twenty pounds; Works and Buildings.

For Roads, Streets and Bridges, a sum not exceeding seven hundred and fifty pounds; Roads, Streets, and Bridges.

For Miscellaneous Services, a sum not exceeding sixty-five pounds; Miscellaneous Services.

For interest on Debentures, a sum not exceeding ninety pounds; Interest on Debentures.

For Aborigines, a sum not exceeding three hundred and twenty-eight pounds; Aborigines.

For the Harbour Master, a sum not exceeding one hundred and four pounds; Harbour Master.

For Repayment of Debt due to the Commissariat, a sum not exceeding five hundred pounds; Debt due to Commissariat.

For Church Debenture, due December, one thousand eight hundred and fifty, a sum not exceeding one hundred pounds; Church Debenture.

in the manner more particularly set forth and detailed under each head of expenditure respectively in the Schedule hereunto annexed, marked No. 2.

III. AND be it enacted, that the Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay from time to time any sum or sums of money for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively in that behalf hereinbefore specified, to such persons and in such portions as the Governor for the time being shall, by any order or orders in writing signed by him, from time to time direct, and the said Treasurer shall in his accounts be allowed credit for all sums Treasurer to pay sums specified as Governor may order, And to be allowed credit in his accounts.
