(CONSOLIDATED FUND) ACT
(No. 3) 1994**

No. 99 of 1994

AN ACT to appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund a sum for recurrent payments made during the year ended 30 June 1994 under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 1993*.

[Assented to 29 December 1994.]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1.** This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 3) 1994*.

Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Appropriation of purpose

3. The sum of \$66 067 906.46 being payments of an extraordinary or unforeseen nature made under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 1993* and charged to the Consolidated Fund under that Act, is appropriated for the recurrent services and purposes expressed in Schedule 1.
