

CONSUMER AFFAIRS.

No. 24 of 1983.

AN ACT to amend the Consumer Affairs Act
1971-1983.

[Assented to 1 December 1983.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Consumer Affairs Amendment Act 1983*. Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Consumer Affairs Act 1971-1983 is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted as approved 12 July 1977 and amended by Acts Nos. 90 of 1978, 66 of 1980, 110 of 1981, 52 of 1982 and 2 of 1983.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Consumer Affairs Act 1971-1983.

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) in subsection (2) by inserting before “, a person who carries on a trade or business” the following—

“ , but subject to subsection (2a) of this section ”; and

(b) by inserting, after subsection (2), the following subsection—

“ (2a) A person who carries on an agricultural, apicultural, pastoral, horticultural, orcharding, viticultural or other farming undertaking does not carry on a trade or business for the purposes of subsection (2) of this section. ”.
