AN ACT to render valid a General Rate made by the Municipality of Coolgardie for the current year.

[Assented to, 28th October, 1898.]

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to whether the General Rate made by the Municipal Council of Coolgardie for the current year was lawfully made, and whether the provisions of the Municipal Institutions Act, 1895, relating thereto, were duly complied with, and it is expedient to give validity to the said rate: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. NOTWITHSTANDING that the provisions of the Municipal Institutions Act, 1895, may not have been complied with by the Council of the Municipality of Coolgardie in striking the General Rate for the current year, or in any matter or thing relating thereto, nevertheless the said rate shall be deemed to have been duly and lawfully

made, and the provisions of the Municipal Institutions Act, 1895, to have been in all respects duly complied with, and the said rate shall be deemed to be good and valid for all purposes, and shall be recoverable by the said Council accordingly.
